ORDER FOR PLAINTIFF TO COMPLY
WITH FLORIDA RULES OF CIVIL PROCEDURE

THIS CAUSE comes upon the Court's own motion. Upon review of the docket, the Court finds as follows:

1. The parties entered into a settlement agreement to resolve the instant case and filed a Notice of Settlement, or participated in mediation and a Mediation Report indicating parties reached full settlement was filed by the mediator.
2. The subject settlement agreement remains pending at this time.
3. No further judicial resolution is needed at this time.

Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. Counsel for Plaintiff is directed to submit the following documents to the Court within 30 days: 1) a voluntary dismissal or proposed order of dismissal for this action; and 2) a completed Final Disposition Form (Form 1.998) pursuant to Rule 1.545 of the Florida Rules of Civil Procedure.
2. Any party desiring the instant action remains in open or active status shall file within 30 days of this Order: 1) a written submission on the status of the case; and 2) a written submission on good cause for the case to remain open or active.
3. Any party desiring the instant action remains in open or active status is encouraged to consult and confer with opposing counsel in an effort to draft a mutually acceptable Agreed Mandatory Civil Case Management Order for submission to the court pursuant to Florida Supreme Court AOSC21-17, Administrative Order 2021-012, and subsequent administrative orders.
